'Another advantage is that this leaves more time for our sales specialists to give advice on the many in-depth technical details. Our experience so far shows us that the time windows for customer meetings are increasingly short. If we no longer have to talk about the basics within our customers' tight time frame, because they've already seen the vehicle in the showroom, there's more time for complex technical details or business management questions,' Strautmann states.

The virtual showroom is therefore an integral part of Langendorf's new website, which has been completely relaunched. More pictures, faster information and a high degree of user-friendliness were the relaunch focus. 'Our demand for the revision,' says Dr Strautmann, 'was that it be as simple and clear as possible.' 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


product page structure deserves special mention: it enables the visitor to find out about the wide range of products even more quickly.
